AFIRMATIVA	
I / You <b>work</b>	
He / She / It <b>works</b>	
We / You / They <b>work</b>	
NEGATIVA	FORMAS CONTRAÍDAS
I / You <b>do not work</b>	I / You <b>don't work</b>
He / She / It <b>does not work</b>	He / She / It <b>doesn't work</b>
We / You / They <b>do not work</b>	We / You / They <b>don't work</b>
INTERROGATIVE	RESPUESTAS BREVES
<b>Do I / you listen to music?</b>	<b>Yes, I / you do.</b> <b>No, I / you don't.</b>
<b>Does he / she / it listen to music?</b>	<b>Yes, he / she / it does.</b> <b>No, he / she / it doesn't.</b>
<b>Do we / you / they listen to music?</b>	<b>Yes, we / you do.</b> <b>No. we / you don't.</b>

Se usa el **presente simple** para expresar rutinas, hábitos y costumbres.

We **have** a shower at 9:30 every day.    Nos  **duchamos** a las 9:30 cada día.

She **plays** tennis on Mondays.    Ella **juega** al tenis los lunes.

### REGLAS PARA FORMAR LA 3ª PERSONA DEL SIGULAR.

- Se añade una **-s** a la mayor parte de los verbos:  
eat → eats                      walk → walks                      like → likes
- Si el verbo termina en **-ch, -sh, -s, -z, -x**, se añade **-es**.  
finish → finishes                      mix → mixes                      catch → catches
- A los verbos **go y do** se les añade **-es**. go → goes                      do → does
- A los verbos que terminan en **consonante + y** se les quita la **-y** y se les añade **-ies**.  
cry → cries                      try → tries
- A los que terminan en **vocal + y** se les añade una **-s**. stay → stays
