ECTA presented in four formats

- **The document:** For a teacher's detailed view, question selection and hard copies.
- **in Google Forms:** For students to assess the teacher and obtain useful spreadsheets which can be beautifully presented.
- **In Kahoot!:** For students, to assess the teacher and have fun (40-50 min)
- **In Picklers:** For students, to assess the teacher when there are no devices available to play kahoot with (50-60 min).
