2. Answer the questions. Write full sentences.

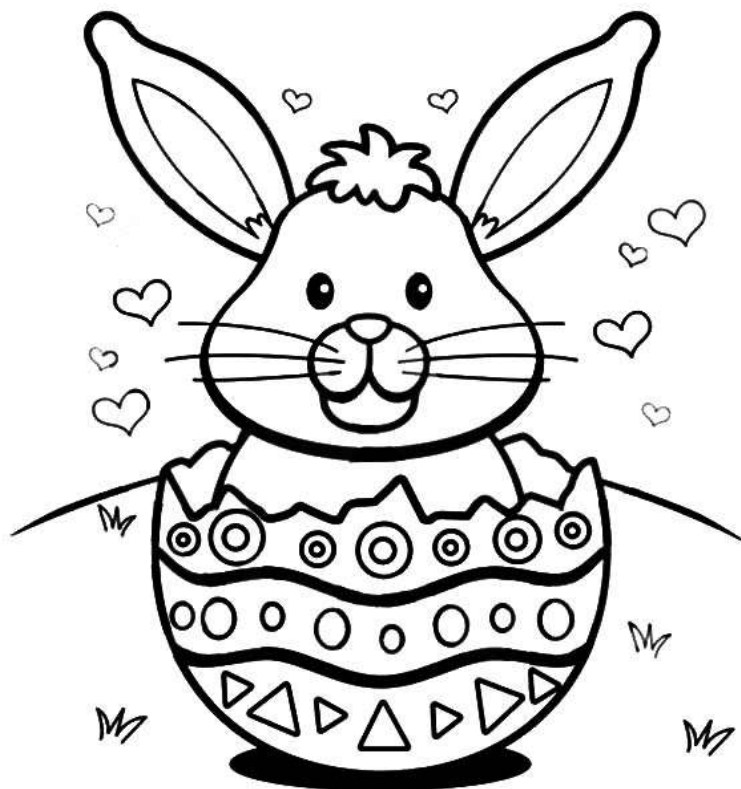
A. Is Easter always the same day on the calendar? What day is it this year?
