BOGGLE OVERVIEW: Boggle is a word game that requires 16 letter cubes, a grid, a 3-minute timer and task cards. The game requires a minimum of two players with no maximum.

Players have three minutes to find as many words as they can in the grid, according to the following rules:Words must be related to the 'task card'.Words must contain at least three letters.No letter cube may be used more than once within a single word.
$\square$ Write your words. You can put each word on a new line or separate the words with spaces or commas. It does not matter whether you use upper or lower case letters.When the time is up, calculate your score as follows:

$\square$ Full credit is awarded for both the singular and plural forms of a noun provided you list them as separate words, so cat and cats each score a point. The same is true for all other derived forms (e.g. chew, chews, chewed, etc.).If a word appears more than once in the grid, it may not be counted twice. Also, multiple meanings of the same word do not earn multiple credit.

- Any dictionary word is allowed. As in most word games, you will not receive credit for proper names, abbreviations, contractions, hyphenated words, or foreign words that are not in an English dictionary. You will be penalised 1 point for each guess you make that is not recognised as a valid word.
