- **CHAUCER'S CHARACTERIZATION:** How does Chaucer characterise each pilgrim? Which type of person is this pilgrim? Include two details to support this characterisation.
- **CHAUCER'S ATTITUDE:** What is Chaucer's attitude toward each pilgrim? Remember Chaucer's use of irony! (i.e. what he says is not always what he means)
